

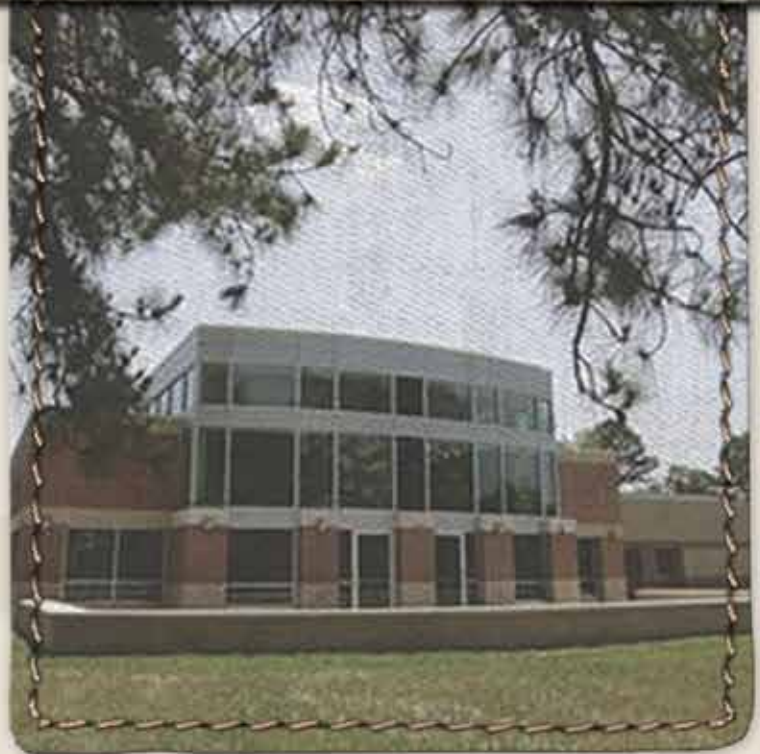

Active Duty Acute Services Unit

We provide a stigma-free, intensive treatment environment specifically designed to meet the psychological needs of Active Duty personnel. Inpatient crisis stabilization and resiliency training designed to treat and support all branches of the Armed Forces on a ‘military only’ unit.

Active Duty Partial Hospitalization and Outpatient Programs

As part of the full continuum of care, Poplar Springs offers partial hospitalization, intensive outpatient services and outpatient therapy to meet the individual needs of each patient throughout his or her healing process.

TRICARE certified acute programs treating the service member’s dependents:

Acute Services for Adults

We offer personalized treatment in an intensive, short-term inpatient setting, with structured, 24-hour psychiatric nursing care. Our clinical experts help patients find their way back to healthier and productive lives.

Acute Services for Adolescents 11-17

Our structured, short-term inpatient program is designed to help adolescents in crisis learn how to deal with their emotional and behavioral issues so they can quickly return home with better coping tools to deal with stress.

Residential Services for Boys & Girls 11-17

Adolescent boys and girls ages 11-17 who demonstrate a persistent pattern of emotional and/or behavioral issues that are disruptive and frequent may benefit from residential care. Our secure campus allows the opportunity for our residents to walk daily to their education classes, treatment groups and cafeteria-style dining.

KEY FEATURES

Poplar Springs Hospital is committed to providing a stigma-free treatment environment specifically designed to meet the needs of the active duty military. Our inpatient mental health unit provides treatment for the emotional and psychological effects of combat theater stress and post-deployment adjustment-related issues. Soldiers may step down to our partial hospitalization program to assist with transitioning back to their duty stations.

Treatment program uses cognitive behavioral therapeutic approaches and guidelines from the Department of Veteran Affairs and Department of Defense for PTSD treatment.

Intensive treatment modalities include: individual, group and family therapies, substance abuse education and treatment, activity therapies, nursing education and psychiatric assessments and evaluations by a psychiatrist.
